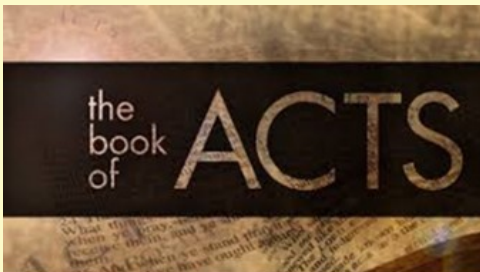

When Luke wrote his Gospel, it was originally part of a two book series. In fact, some scholars believe that Luke's real intention was to write a trilogy of which the last volume was lost or never completed. In any event, Luke and Acts were broken up in the New Testament with Luke being placed with the other Gospels and Acts being placed as an introduction to the writings of Paul.

The Book of Acts is the critical link between Jesus and the early Church. Join Pastor Mark as we follow the early Apostles' journey into the Greco-Roman world of their times.

In some ways, the original challenge for church in the 1st century is not unlike the challenge facing the church in 21st century Canada. Wednesday mornings starting on April 22 from 10:30am to Noon.
